1 THE COLLEGE

- d) Description of how your faith affects your daily life.

4 SELECTION CRITERIA

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate at interview a personal faith and commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ and a lifestyle consistent with that faith, including an active commitment to a Christian fellowship, as well as the following skills and experience:

- excellent skills in communicating with students and parents;
- the ability to teach individual students and group lessons as required by the Academy administrator;
- the willingness to contribute to the development of performance opportunities held at Norwest Christian College as required by the Academy administrator.

5 APPLICATION

Applications should contain:

- a) a covering letter;
- b) a resume including relevant academic and work history, as well as professional experience and achievements;
- c) contact details for two professional referees and the minister/pastor of their current church; and
- d) copies of qualifications, including academic transcripts.

6 INTERVIEW

- d) demonstrate high quality teaching skills in one or more lesson demonstration/s.
